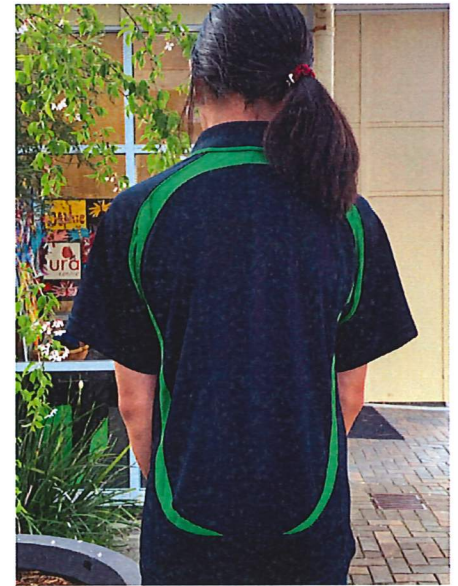
With this being the last week of Term Three it is time to remind you of a few important things to remember for the start of Term Four on Monday 17th October. **Sunhats must** be worn when outside in Term 1 and Term 4. This is a school policy and ensures our children are sun safe. If your child is not wearing a hat, they will be directed to a shady area. The portable **swimming pool** will be up and lessons will start in week 2. Please ensure your child comes to school with their togs and a towel on their swimming days. A swimming timetable will be released this week.

With the mask mandate no longer in place, please remember to keep your child home if they have any cold symptoms. This will help us to stop the transmission of colds and flu's and keep everyone healthy. Thank you for your cooperation.

Next year we are introducing our new uniform for seniors (year 7 and 8) as pictured below. The uniforms are made of quick dry material and 'pill' resistant'. The supplier also assures me that they are sweat wicking and won't smell – which is great for our active and sweaty seniors who spend most of their breaks playing rugby, netball or volleyball! The polo shirts will be available to purchase – keep an eye out for where and how. **These new polo shirts will be compulsory for year 7 from the start of 2023 and will be optional for Year 8 students.** Next year the Yr 0-6 uniform will remain the same until we use the majority of the existing stock. Then they will be replaced with a new design that will be the reverse of the Senior uniform – green with navy accents.



Next term we will be finalising the details for **Yrs 5-6 (13–17 February)** and **Yrs 7-8 (21-24 February)** camps being held at Camp Tupare in South Head. Year 7/8 will have the first week at camp, they return and Yr 5/6 go to camp. More information from Team Leaders will be coming out next term. Keep an eye out for permission and medical information slips – these help us to ensure we cater to all needs and requirements. We will also need parent helpers, so book your leave if you want to join us. The gear list will also come out, so you will have heaps of time to source everything required.
